152	Mayors' Board
	The town clerk informed the meeting that the deposit had been paid so that the work
	could commence. It had been hoped that the chairman would have been able by now
	to have viewed the work in progress; however to date this has not been possible.
153	Mayor Choosing and Mayor's Sunday
	It was agreed that the Council Chamber would be set up on the Friday 11 th May ready
	for the event on the 14 th May. A rehearsal would take place on Friday 11 th May
	commencing at 2pm so that everyone involved in the event was clear about their

	duties. It was agreed that the parade on Sunday 20 th May would leave Fore Street at 10.40am. The town clerk would contact Mark Newsham from the Sea Cadets regarding the Parade Marshal for this event.
154	Deputy Mayor Cllr S Griggs informed the meeting that having discovered that Cllr J Jordan had been so disappointed at not being selected as Deputy Mayor she had decided to step down from the position so that he could enjoy the privilege of that office for the ensuing year. She pointed out to the meeting that she had already had the honour of holding that position, so considered that Cllr Jordan should also have that opportunity. Cllr Jordan thanked Cllr Griggs for allowing him that privilege and stated that he would do his best for the council in that position during the year. Cllr W Buke stated that he hoped that Cllr Jordan would enjoy his year as Deputy Mayor.
155	Mayor's Dinner Cllr J Rendle, Mayor elect from May 2018, informed the meeting that she was thinking of altering the format of the dinner to follow more in line with what some of the other Town Councils do. She felt that it should be more of a charity dinner. At present she was still thinking about the venue. She was concerned that providing entertainment was expensive and pointed out that last year because the disco did not start until 11pm many of the guests left. She was also not sure when she was going to have the event, although she felt it might be better later in the year, possibly in September. It was agreed that this event was down to the Mayor and that the meeting would support her decision.
