136	Minutes The minutes of the meeting held on the 4 th December 2017 were adopted as a true record; and were signed by the chairman.

139	Mayors' Board The gentleman who had previously quoted for the work was now unable to undertake the work because of poor health. The Mayor and Chairman had met with a Mr Cottrell from Cottrell Joinery who could undertake this project for £4,120 plus vat. Councillors were circulated with a drawing of what the board would look like. It would fit under the window ledge so that it was near to the present board. The town clerk stated that we would need to vire across some of our budget to be able to meet this cost, however if necessary we would have to request funds from the council's general reserves. Resolved that the Mayors' Board be commissioned using Cottrell Joinery at the cost of £4,120 plus Vat.

	Tiverton Branch of the RBL and MDDC would also purchase one each.

	Town clerk reported that our Events Co-ordinator is working on a number of possibl
	acts for this concert. The Tiverton Town Band have agreed to attend. Steve Knightly
	Miranda Sykes, East Devon Choral Society, Lost Sound Dartmoor Folk Choir, the
	Tiverton High School, Blundell's School and the Widecombe Singers have all been approached.
