	Cllr S Flaws provided the meeting with an update regarding the arrangements for this
	event, which are well in hand. It was agreed that a double sided banner would be

	exclusive of Vat. This price would include erection and dismantling of the banner. A
	meeting had been arranged for the 1 st March with Mr R McBride to discuss first aid provision. The New Hall Manager would provide trestle tables and a tea urn for the

	provided rather than pasties, with people being able to purchase more food at Van

90	HMS Enterprise It was now confirmed that HMS Enterprise and The Royal Marne band would visit Tiverton on Sunday 30 th April. The town clerk went through the arrangements for the day. Road closure orders would now be applied for and security measures and risk assessments put into place. The Mayor would take the salute in Fore Street. The event would be publicised once that was agreed with the security services.

92	Sage VC The town clerk informed the meeting that unfortunately the principle funder for the proposed Memorial Garden in Phoenix Lane had stated that they were no longer willing to fund the project, therefore the VC Slab needed to be located elsewhere. The town clerk had explored various locations with the Conservation Officer, and it was felt that the most suitable location would be on the wall of the Memorial Hall. The town clerk had approached Sir Ian Amory regarding this, and he had felt that this would be a good idea, and would put it to the trustees of the Memorial Hall. The committee were all agreed that the Memorial Hall would be the best location for the Sage VC Slab.
