047	Matters Arising

048	Democratic Period
	No members of public attended.
049	Feast of St James
	It was agreed that this event would not take place in 2021 because there was
	insufficient time to prepare for it and there was still some uncertainty regarding social
	distancing rules. The committee would begin preparations for 2022.
050	Events Sub-committee
	It was agreed that membership of this group would be selected after the Annual
	Council meeting in May.
051	Devon General Bus Society Vintage Bus Day
	The Town Clerk explained that the idea was to recreate for the day the bus services
	that ran in Tiverton in 1963/4. These included services to Silverton, Sampford
	Peverell, Rackenford, Cruwys Morchard, Cheriton Fitzpaine, Stoodleigh, plus a
	number of town services. All bus trips would be free of charge and would operate
	from selected bays at the bus station. It was agreed to use £500 from the Special

	Covid-19 Town Grant towards this event. It was hoped that cafes, pubs and restaurants would be open for this event.
052	Other Possible Events in 2021 It was noted that there was to be a Food Festival in the town on the 26 th September. This is not being organised by the Town Council, but should be a good event. It was hoped that the Christmas light switch on for 2021 would be a really super event. Cllr Griggs stated that there was a need to possibly do some fund raising for that. Some of the traders had wanted to expand the areas covered by the Christmas Lights, but had been made aware that they would have to pay for any additional lights over and above what had already been contracted for. It was hoped that there would be a veterans day this year, and of course the usual Remembrance day. It was hoped that MDDC would have some electric night's events
